Executive summary of the 10th meeting of the Infrastructure Advisory Group of the European High Performance Computing (EuroHPC) Joint Undertaking

Tuesday 4, February 2020, Barcelona

Executive Summary

The 10th meeting of the EuroHPC Infrastructure Advisory Group (INFRAG) took place in Barcelona on 4th February 2020. The group focused on the discussions for the next European Union Multiannual Financial Framework, the role of HPC technologies and EuroHPC and how INFRAG is expected to contribute to the shaping of an EU HPC Infrastructure roadmap. These ideas will help to shape the next version of the INFRAG Multiannual Strategic Agenda that should be delivered within 2020.

The group also discussed the progress of the three Working Groups. Members agreed on the actions required for the Scientific WG in order to approach relevant stakeholders and collect necessary input. Regarding the Industrial Users requirements WG, the Task Force initiated by Teratec and HLRS has been identified as an important initiative to follow and collaborate with. Finally, concerning the Access Policy WG, it was agreed that the current mandate has been fulfilled, and the group would expect an updated mandate from the EuroHPC GB in order to identify the next steps for shaping the EuroHPC systems Access Policy.

The next meeting is planned to take place during the EuroHPC Summit Week 2020 in Porto, where a number of important sessions and meetings are organised to which INFRAG is planning to contribute.
