

EuroHPC JOINT UNDERTAKING DECISION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EuroHPC JOINT UNDERTAKING No 18/2023

Approving the list of proposals selected for funding pursuant to the evaluation of the call for proposal on EuroHPC Training Platform and support to the International HPC Summer School (DIGITAL-EUROHPC-JU-2022-TRAINING-02)

THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROHPC JOINT UNDERTAKING,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2021/1173 of 13 July 2021 on establishing the European High Performance Computing Joint Undertaking and repealing Regulation (EU) 2018/1488¹,

Having regard to the Statutes of the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking annexed to Regulation 2018/1488 (thereinafter "Statutes") and in particular to Article 7(5)(d) thereof,

Having regard to the Financial Rules of the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking adopted by the Governing Board on 20 February 2020 and in particular to Article 45 thereof,

Having regard to the Governing Board Decision No 41/2022, of 5 December 2022, amending the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking's Work Plan and Budget for the year 2022 (Amendment No. 5),

Having regard to the Governing Board Decision No 36/2022, of 25 November 2022, approving the launch of a call for proposal to develop a EuroHPC training portal and a EuroHPC Summer School,

WHEREAS

- (1) Pursuant to the Annual Work Plan 2022, the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking launched the Call for proposal on EuroHPC Training Platform and support to the International HPC Summer School (DIGITAL-EUROHPC-JU-2022-TRAINING-02).
- (1) By 12 April 2023, one (1) proposal was submitted in response to the call. The proposal was checked for compliance with the admissibility requirements and eligibility

conditions of the call. The compliance check concluded that the proposal is admissible and eligible.

- (2) The admissible and eligible proposal was evaluated by a panel of independent experts, in accordance with the call and the Digital Europe Programme rules for participation, and in line with the EuroHPC JU's amended Annual Work Programme 2022.
- (3) The Executive Director has submitted to the Governing Board for approval the proposal selected for funding. One (1) eligible proposal has passed the relevant threshold and shall be retained for funding. No reserve list needs to be established.
- (4) The Governing Board took note and acknowledged the report of the Executive Director on the outcome of the call for proposal which includes the Call Evaluation Report with its annexes as well as the evaluation summary reports which will be attached to the individual notification letter.
- (5) The Governing Board should approve the list of actions selected for funding on the basis of the ranking list produced by a panel of independent experts.
- (6) The Executive Director should implement the decision of the Governing Board,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The ranked list pertaining to the call for proposal on EuroHPC Training Platform and support to the International HPC Summer School (DIGITAL-EUROHPC-JU-2022-TRAINING-02) including the proposal selected for funding, with indications of the maximum Union funding to be allocated for the selected proposal (Annex 1) is approved.

Article 2

The Executive Director shall inform the applicant of the result of the evaluation and shall communicate simultaneously the relevant individual evaluation summary report as an attachment to the notification letter. The notification letter sent by the Executive Director to the action selected for funding shall invite the applicant to start the grant agreement preparation.

Article 3

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption
