

FAQ for EuroHPC JU Call: International cooperation between Japan and the EU on quantum computing (HORIZON-EUROHPC-JU-2024-INCO-06)

Q1: Where can interested entities find an appropriate consortium to partner with for this particular call?

A1: Please observe that the <u>EU Funding & Tenders Portal</u> provides the opportunity to interested entities to advertise their envisioned contributions and roles in a potential consortium. The respective tab is found under "**Partner search announcements**".

Q2: What are the guidelines for allocating access time to EuroHPC systems? Who is eligible to request access to EuroHPC computing resources?

A2: Please observe that all access to EuroHPC systems is regulated by the EuroHPC regulation (Key Documents - EuroHPC JU), in particular Article 16 "Use of EuroHPC supercomputers". Pursuant of Articles 16,3/16,4 only users residing, established or located in a Member State or in a third country associated to the Digital Europe Programme (DEP) or to Horizon Europe (HE) shall be granted the Union's share of access time to EuroHPC systems.

Please also observe the EuroHPC Peer-Review's Office FAQ addressing the most relevant questions around access time to EuroHPC systems <u>Access Policy and FAQ - EuroHPC JU</u>.

Q3: While the call conditions outline a page limit for Part B of 70 pages, the provided template refers to a 45 page limit. What is the correct page limit?

A3: Due to a glitch in the configuration of the submission system, the page limit was incorrectly set. The correct **page limit** for Part B is outlined in the call conditions to be **70**.
