



EUROPEAN HIGH PERFORMANCE COMPUTING JOINT UNDERTAKING

Summary of the 5th meeting of the Infrastructure Advisory Group (INFRAG) of the European High Performance Computing (EuroHPC) Joint Undertaking 13 May 2019

Executive Summary

The fifth meeting of the EuroHPC Infrastructure Advisory Group (INFRAG) took place in Poznan, Poland, during the EuroHPC Summit Week conference. The meeting was actually split over two days and in multiple private or joint meetings with other HPC groups. In particular the group met with the PRACE Scientific Steering Committee (SSC) and the EuroHPC Research and Infrastructure Advisory Group (RIAG).

During the private meetings the main focus of the group was the preparation of the document on the long term EuroHPC Mission and Strategy, which will be compiled with contributions of both INFRAG and RIAG. The INFRAG members agreed to start working independently on the document and meet on 5 June in Brussels to merge their contributions, further develop the text and assess the timeline for the development of the strategy in the coming period.

Overall, INFRAG had a strong presence during the EuroHPC Summit Week Event. The group participated in the EuroHPC BoF session in which the INFRAG chair Claus-Axel Muller presented the group, its mandate, the work performed so far and the future plans. In the same session the leaders of the various INFRAG working groups (WGs) presented the individual WG goals and invited interested stakeholders to contribute. Finally, Zoe Cournia participated in the discussion panel on “The future of scientific and industrial computing in Europe”, representing INFRAG within her role of the Industrial User Requirements WG co-leader.
