

# EuroHPC JOINT UNDERTAKING DECISION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EuroHPC JOINT UNDERTAKING No 13/2021

# Approving the proposals selected for funding pursuant to the evaluation of the Call for proposals H2020-JTI-EuroHPC-2020-02

THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EuroHPC JOINT UNDERTAKING,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2018/1488 of 28 September 2018 establishing the European High Performance Computing (HPC) Joint Undertaking (hereinafter "Regulation")<sup>1</sup>,

Having regard to the Statutes the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking annexed to the Regulation (thereinafter "Statutes") and in particular to Article 7(5)(d) thereof,

Having regard to the Financial Rules of the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking adopted by the Governing Board on 20 February 2020 and in particular to Article 45 thereof,

Having regard to Decision of the Governing Board of the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking No 1/2020 of 10 March 2020, approving the amended annual Work Plan of the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking for the year 2020,

Having regard to Decision of the Governing Board of the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking No 18/2020 of 6 July 2020, adopting the launch of the call H2020-JTI-EuroHPC-2020-2: Framework Partnership Agreement in European low-power microprocessor technologies (Phase 2),

#### **WHEREAS**

- (1) Pursuant to the amended Annual Work Plan 2020 adopted by Decision of the Governing Board No 1/2020 of 10 March 2020, the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking launched on 6 July 2020 the call H2020-JTI-EuroHPC-2020-2: Framework Partnership Agreement in European low-power microprocessor technologies (Phase 2),
- (2) The call for proposal H2020-JTI-EuroHPC-2020-02 was opened on 18 August 2020 providing as deadline for submitting grant applications by 12 January 2021 at the latest.

- (3) By 12 January 2021, one (1) proposal was submitted in response to the call via the Funding and Tenders Portal of the European Commission. The proposal was verified for its compliance with the admissibility requirements and eligibility conditions of the call. During the verification it was concluded that the proposal was admissible and eligible.
- (4) The evaluation of the proposal for this call was carried out according to the rules and procedures of Horizon 2020.
- (5) As a result of the evaluation, one (1) eligible proposals has passed the relevant thresholds and was retained for funding.
- (6) The Governing Board should approve the actions selected for funding on the basis of the call evaluation report and limiting the financial contribution of the EuroHPC Joint Undertaking to EUR 35 million as provided in the call for proposal.
- (7) The Executive Director has submitted to the Governing Board for approval the ranked list of proposals attached as Annex 1 selected for funding.
- (8) The Governing Board took note and acknowledged the Report of the Executive Director on the outcome of the call for proposals H2020-JTI-EuroHPC-2020-02, which includes the Call Evaluation Report with its annexes as well as the evaluation summary reports which will be attached to the individual notification letters.
- (9) The Executive Director should implement the decision of the Governing Board.

#### HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

#### Article 1

On the call for proposal H2020-JTI-EuroHPC-2020-02, the Governing Board approves the proposal selected for funding (1) limiting EuroHPC Joint Undertaking contribution to EUR 35 million as provided in the call for proposal.

#### Article 2

The Executive Director shall inform the applicant of the result of the evaluation and shall communicate simultaneously the relevant evaluation summary report, as attachment to the notification letter. The notification letter sent by the Executive Director shall invite the applicant to start the grant preparation.

#### Article 3

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
