**DECISION OF THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EuroHPC JOINT**  
**UNDERTAKING No 18/2019**

**On the application by analogy of the Implementing Rules of the Staff Regulations  
adopted by the Commission**

THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE EUROHPC JOINT UNDERTAKING,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union ('Staff Regulations') and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union ('CEOS'), laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, Euratom, ECSC) No 259/68<sup>1</sup>, and in particular Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EU) 2018/1488 of 28 September 2018 establishing the European High Performance Computing Joint Undertaking<sup>2</sup> (hereinafter 'EuroHPC JU') and in particular articles 16 and 17 thereof,

Having regard to the Communication C(2014)6543 final of 26 September 2014 from Vice-President Šefčovič to the Commission on the guidelines on the implementation of Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations with regard to the implementing rules applicable in the agencies, and in particular Point 2.B thereof,

After informing the staff,

Whereas:

- (1) It is necessary to adopt implementing rules for giving effect to the Staff Regulations;
- (2) The Commission informed the JU in written on 10 April 2019 of the necessity to adopt the decisions referred to in the Annex to this decision;
- (3) In application of Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations, the above-mentioned Decisions shall apply by analogy to the agencies either nine months after the date of its adoption or by decision of the Governing Board, at an earlier date;

HAS ADOPTED THE FOLLOWING DECISION:
